<u>CPL ARTICLE 360:</u> JURY TRIAL (LOCAL CRIMINAL COURT).

Local Criminal Court jury is composed of six (6) members; plus 1 or 2 alternates as Court directs (or none).

Challenges for cause include those for Superior Court jurors, as well as: if juror was witness on civil proceeding relating to same action; or was witness on the same criminal case in Superior Court/Grand Jury, before direction to file Prosecutor's Information.

Each <u>side</u> gets 3 peremptory challenges for regular jurors, plus 1 **only** for alternate(s) (multiple defendants treated as single party).

The Court <u>*MAY*</u> dismiss counts not supported by the evidence, and issue Trial order of Dismissal. If misdemeanor charge so dismissed, Court may submit lesser-included offense; <u>**must**</u> at People's request.

For any other misdemeanor charge where such <u>would</u> be supportable by evidence, Court *may* submit lesser-included offenses "in the alternative".
