

CPLR ARTICLE 80: FEES.

SUBPOENA = witness entitled to \$15, + 23 cents per mile for travel expenses (no fee for travel wholly in-city); an additional fee of \$3.00 is due for a *non*-party required to testify before trial (e.g. at a deposition).

TRANSCRIPTS: = of records, NOT court minutes! = 10 cents per folio (double-sided page).

STENOGRAPHIC MINUTES: as set by Chief Administrator.

REFEREE = \$50/day; NOT apply to Judicial Hearing Officers [JHOs]!

RECEIVER= 5%; or if such amount would be less, Court can allow up to \$100.

OATHS/ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS = \$2 per person (including witnesses); certified copies = 25 cents per folio, minimum of \$1.

SHERIFF SERVICE = \$15; Sheriff also entitled to mileage, flat fee of \$25 in NYC.

INDEX # = \$190 (\$20 of which goes to the county, \$5 for education, and \$15 for cultural programs [minus Clerk fees of 25 cents and 75 cents respectively]); no fee is required for Mental Health commitments, city plaintiffs, transfers, appeals to County Court, criminal actions, or poor person filings.

CALENDARING FEE = \$125; if Request for Judicial Action is filed first, then \$95 for RJI and \$30 due later.

MOTION = \$45 (not motions to proceed in-pauperis [poor person]).

JURY = \$65.

APPEAL = \$65.
