

CRIMINAL QUIZ 1: ANSWER KEY.

- 1) D; only preliminary jurisdiction.
- 2) C; **or** acting!
- 3) C; Class A felonies or Rape 1 = any time.
- 4) B.
- 5) A; pnyl NYC.
- 6) B; attorney need only be present.
- 7) A; must only be *released* after 30!
- 8) B; and before trial commences, prosecutor must provide within 15 days (or alternatively a refusal).
- 9) A; **MUST!**
- 10) A; only P.L. misdemeanors, or non-P.L. raised to felony by pror conviction.
- 11) B.
- 12) C; *Prosecutor's Information*.
- 13) C.
- 14) A; not "guilty" to Murder 1 unless certain conditions are met.
- 15) B.
- 16) B.
- 17) D; defenant **MUST** be presently capable of comprehending proceedings, same as verdict of "not responsible".
- 18) C; although Superior may also try if indicted together with crime.
- 19) B.
- 20) D; Felony Complaint can **ONLY** charge felonies, although Misdemeanor can also include Petty Offenses.
- 21) D.
- 22) A; no jury, single judge.
- 23) A; unless Drug Court indicates earlier acceptance.
- 24) C; B/C both = 15, all others = 10.
- 25) C.
- 26) C.
- 27) C; i.e. "the People of the State of New York".
- 28) C; Court send to defense counsel/pro se defendant.
- 29) A; guilty plea only with Court approval.
- 30) C; but Superior only by Grand Jury.
- 31) C, and at least 16 must be present.
- 32) B; only Assault 1, also Murder 2 can be 13 years old while all others only 14-15.
